XMP/XKN container with steel doors used on wide body aircraft B77W/A330/ A340. ULDs are secured with steel seals.



Narrow body aircraft



DKH container with steel doors used on narrow body aircraft A319/A320/A321. ULDs are secured with steel seals.



DZH container with steel doors used on narrow body aircraft A319 only. ULDs are secured with steel seals.



VAL boxes are no official ULDs and are secured with plastic seals. They may be used on all aircraft.

Max. permissible load: 35 kg

- On flights with a stopover, it is mandatory to use XMP/XKN/DKH units whenever available.
- On A319, if no DKH or AKH is assigned, the VAL shipment must be loaded into DZH container.
- When accepting bookings, please consider that XMP/XKN/DKH containers do not have the same dimensions as the AMP/AVE/AKH containers.
- During bookings, please make sure to ask for dimensions and weight of the shipment in order to be able to assign it to a ULD or VAL box respectively.
